All these items can be purchased at any local grocery store.

- frozen Turkey (12 – 14 lbs.)
- box of stuffing
- jars of gravy
- can of corn or green beans
- box instant potatoes
- eggs
- dessert: cake mix with frosting or brownie mix or dry pudding
- corn bread mix
- can of cranberry sauce
- dinner rolls
- box of mac and cheese
- box of rice

10 Islamic Thanksgiving baskets

In the Islamic faith, the term “halal” means lawful or permitted. You can buy halal meat (chicken, lamb, etc., but no turkeys please) at Sahara Halal Market at 365 Allen St. in New Britain or any Price Rite. You can ask store employees to assist you.

- can of kidney beans
- can of lentil beans
- box of basmati rice
- jar of tomato sauce
- halal chicken or lamb
- sazón goya
- popcorn
- any fruit
- dessert: cake mix with frosting or brownie mix or dry pudding

Please keep perishable foods refrigerated. The meat(s) must be frozen.

Boxes, paper bags or laundry baskets with the foodstuffs need to be brought to church **prior to worship on November 23rd**, the Sunday before Thanksgiving.
